In the early 1950's, the then called "Centre d'études nucléaires de Saclay" opened at the initiative of Raoul Dautry and Frédéric Joliot-Curie. Nowadays, the so-called Plateau de Saclay sees the fast-evolving and largest aggregation of scientific and technological research and high education in France. .
